

'And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years to come; take your ease, eat, drink and be merry."' Luke 12:19

In our culture it is surprising to find many expressions that came from the bible. For instance we use the expression 'a wolf in sheep's clothing' to speak of a charlatan, who seems harmless, but actually doesn't mean us well. Jesus called false prophets wolves in sheep's clothing. Another such expression is 'eat, drink and be merry,' again words from the lips of Jesus. They came on an occasion when a man asked Him to tell his brother to divide the family inheritance with him. Jesus' answer was that he hadn't been appointed a judge or arbitrator over them. But He added the warning to beware against



every form of greed; 'for not even when one has abundance does his life consist of his possessions.' And Jesus went on to tell a parable about a rich man, whose land was very productive, so that he began reasoning to himself, saying, 'What shall I do, since I have no place to store my crops? This is what I will do: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years to come; take your ease, eat, drink and be merry.' But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your soul is required of you; and who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' So is the man who stores up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God." The apostle Paul wrote something similar in 1 Corinthians 15:32 with the statement that 'If the dead are not raised, 'Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die.' The idea is that this life is not all there is. God is there on the other side, and meeting Him is what a person must be prepared for. Life is really very short compared to eternity.

Office News



Did you know that Valle Vista Property Owners Association sends a list of delinquent accounts to a Collection Agency every year? This has been taking place since 2011!!! The list is prepared by Assistant Property Manager and is comprised of all accounts/lots in arrears, be it one year or more. The Collection Agency takes the responsibility of contacting the owners and requesting payment.

For this service they are paid 25% of monies collected. All accounts in arrears are assessed a Collection Agency Fee to cover this contingency. Those who do not pay are reported to the various Credit Reporting agencies such as Experion, Equifax and Transunion, as well as having their lot(s) liened with Mohave

County. Once VVPOA has received past due monies, the Collection Agency in turn contacts the credit reporting agencies to let them know the account has been settled. Since October of 2011, **VVPOA has netted \$142,660!**

In the last two years Valle Vista has seen a lot of homes (and some lots too!) exchange hands. In 2014 64 homes and 14 lots exchanged hands; in 2015 63 homes and 19 lots exchanged hands. Through the end of September of 2016, 66 homes and 11 lots have been sold/exchanged. VVPOA has had two new homes built in the last year & a half. Now that the Arsenic Treatment Facility is up and operational, the ban on



line extensions for Truxton Canyon Water should be lifted soon! All good news for Valle Vista!
