

'Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.' Joshua 1:9

Those of us who grew up during the cold war, who remember the fallout shelter times, grew up well aware of the great concern over Communism and its subversive anti-American hostility. I recently read about a famous trial that took place in 1949 when I was only 3 years old. It was a 9 month trial in U.S. federal district court in New York, of 11 top-ranking leaders of the Communist Party in America. They were on trial for violating The Smith Act, a law against those who advocated violent overthrow of the U.S. government. Large protests took place daily outside the courthouse and the accused Communists, as well as their attorneys, attempted numerous times to humiliate and aggravate the judge, to provoke his temper and make a mockery of the trial.

The presiding judge was Harold Medina, a Christian and an extremely competent federal judge. He later spoke of the presence of evil in the courtroom. He said that he realized that the Communists were fighting, not so much against himself as a man, but against God Himself and that he sought strength for the battle through prayer, which brought a perfect calm. He said, 'If ever a man felt the presence of Someone standing beside him, strengthening his will, I certainly did, it is not we who pull the strings, we are not the masters..'

The Communist conspirators were convicted and sentenced to 5 years in prison, some of their attorneys convicted of contempt and sentenced to prison as well. Judge Medina was on the cover of Time Magazine twice and served as a professor of law at Columbia University for 22 years. He lived to be a 102.




