And in Lucado's book I read some words of advice he called 'time-tested truths.' The one that stood out was, 'Make major decisions in a cemetery.'

It is certainly true that life is short. The Daily Bread lady asked at the end, 'How can the gift of each moment encourage you to make the most of your time?'


